We are permitted a maximum of 200 people and are required to register everyone for contact tracing purposes.

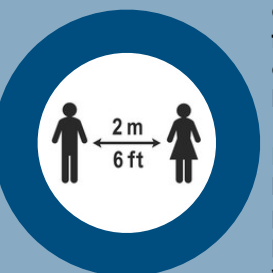
### When you arrive



Enter **ONLY** through the main door and follow the direction of greeters and ushers. They will guide you through registration and lead you directly to your seat.



Please use provided hand sanitizer as you enter the church building and bring any personal items with you into your seat.



Remain a minimum distance of 2 meters from anyone outside of your household bubble at all times.

Hugs and handshakes are not permitted with people outside of your bubble.

### During the Service



We encourage you to participate in prayer and worship, but congregational **SINGING** is not allowed during indoor services.

There will be no children's church or nursery program.



If you need to use a restroom during the service, please move into the nearest aisle and an usher will direct you to the restrooms.

The nursery will be open for nursing mothers and changing.



When the service concludes, ushers will direct each row of people seated, starting at the back of the sanctuary, to exit.

Please leave church immediately as directed.
